A notice of cancellation shall be in writing, and a withdrawal may be effectuated by the student's written notice to the school administrative office, **12400 Firestone Blvd Suite #240 Norwalk, CA 90650** or by email to <a href="mailto:info@erptechnicals.com">info@erptechnicals.com</a> or by the student's conduct, including, but not necessarily limited to, a student's lack of attendance.

The institution shall issue a refund for unearned institutional charges if the student cancels an enrollment agreement or withdraws during a period of attendance. The refund policy for students who have completed 60 percent or less of the period of attendance shall be a pro rata refund. The institution shall pay or credit refunds within 45 days of a student's cancellation or withdrawal.
